- What is Computer Science Principles (CSP)?
 - USC and Code.org work together through the CSP Professional Development Program to help high school teachers and principals add CS classes to the 2023-24 academic schedule by training teachers to implement the Code.org curriculum.
- Who can sign up?
 - Teachers with classes in grades 9-12 are welcome to enroll. No CS experience necessary.
- When are the workshops?
 - Teachers start with a **summer intensive training July 17-21** on how to use Code.org's free, standards-aligned CS curricula. Teachers will also attend **quarterly workshops** during the academic year for additional support as they implement their lessons.
- Where are we meeting?
 - Summer intensive sessions and quarterly workshops will all take place virtually via Zoom.

Teachers are able to submit an application through the link below at no cost. While there is a fee to attend workshops following acceptance into the program, **full scholarships are readily available** and can be applied for *within the program application itself*.
